This position requires general knowledge and supervision for all group situations, safety and the well-being of the campers, Must be certified in CPR/AED and First Aid. This position will administer the daily camp schedule of activities along with preparing crafts, recreational sports; participate in swim time, and overall supervision of the campers.

General Duties:

- Understanding and administering all camp policies and procedures.
- Ability to work with children to grow in character, experiences and insights.
- Oversee the health, well-being and safety of all campers at all times.

Specific Duties:

- Experience working with children.
- Must be 18 years of age.
- Ability to adapt to certain environments such as the outdoors and aquatics.
- Must be enthusiastic, dependable and have a positive attitude in the work environment.
- Attendance to assigned shifts is a priority.

Responsibilities:

- Plan, administer and engage in all camp activities in a positive manner.
- Work with other staff members in a positive and supportive manner.
- Greet campers and families upon arrival and orientate them to camp.
- Encourage all campers to understand and respect the rules and emergency procedures.
- Participate in all camp activities in a positive and nurturing manner.
- Must attend all camp meetings, orientations, and trainings.
- Report any suspicion of child abuse to your camp director and discuss it with no one else.
- Help out where needed in any area of camp to contribute to the successful operation of the camp.

Ability to:

- Oversee the health, well-being and safety of all campers at all times.
