

GROSSE ILE ISLANDFEST FESTIVAL
Rules & Regulations for the 2012 IslandFest “Craft & Art Mart

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE:

- All applications must be postmarked by May 4, 2012
- Make check payable to Grosse Ile Township and be sure to include your completed and signed application.

ALL INFORMATION MUST BE CURRENT. “SAME AS LAST YEAR” WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- **ACCEPTANCE:** The applicant acknowledges decisions with request to applications, will be necessarily subjective and applicant specifically waives, releases, and hold harmless, the Festival Commission, Grosse Ile Municipal Airport and Grosse Ile Township, from any actions, or damages arising out of an application denial.

- **SALE OR PURCHASE:** Grosse Ile Township is not in any way responsible for the sale or purchase of items. Grosse Ile Township is not responsible to enforce the terms of any sales transactions between the vendors and vendees who participate in the IslandFest “Craft and Art Mart”. *No used clothing, only handcrafted or new items.*

- **RIGHT TO PROHIBIT:** Grosse Ile Township has the right to prohibit any item the Township in its discretion deems necessary to protect the general health, safety and welfare of the Township including firearms, stun guns or any other weapons.

- **ASSUMPTION OF RISK: ALL VENDORS** participating in the Festival do so at their own risk. This assumption of risk includes that associated with wind, rain, hail, lightening, floods or other acts of God. Therefore damage to property, illness or injury, by vandals, patrons, fellow participants, or sponsors are at the vendors own risk. The Festival Commission, Grosse Ile Township, Grosse Ile Municipal Airport and its elected officials, employees, agents and volunteers shall not be liable for any damages to or losses of property, injury to persons.

- **BOOTH MAINTENANCE:** You must keep the area clean around your booth. There will be a minimum charge of \$100 if the Festival Commission has to clean your space. It is your responsibility to secure all trip hazards (i.e. electrical cords, hoses, ropes, etc.).

- **Check-in/Vehicle Traffic/ Tear Down:** Upon arrival, check-in at the information booth. Staff will direct you to your area to unload your vehicles. All vendors must be set up and ready for display by 3:00pm on Friday, June 3rd. Pre-festival set-up begins Thursday evening at 5:00pm. Vehicles will not be allowed on festival grounds for delivery or storage during festival hours, which are 4:00pm to 11pm Friday, 8:00am to 11:00pm on Saturday and 7:30am to 4:00pm Sunday. Arrangements should be made in advance for the storage of vehicles and trailers. ALL deliveries coming after the opening of the festival each day will have to be brought in by hand or by special arrangement through the Mart Director by contact at the information booth.

- **FEES:** Rental space is \$50.00 per 10’x10’ space without electric and \$60.00 for a 10’x10’ with electrical. You must provide your own tables and chairs and display racks.

- **GENERAL RULES:** Please be aware that general rules do not allow pets, bottles, cans, bicycles, roller blades, scooters or skateboards in the festival area.

- **LIABILITY:** NO INSURANCE PROVIDED BY THE FESTIVAL COMMISSION. Grosse Ile Township and the Festival Commission shall not be liable for loss damages to equipment or for any injuries to vendors.

- **SANITATION:** Port-a-toilets will be provided throughout the festival area.

- **SECURITY:** Security will be provided for observation only after festivals closing hours.

- **USE OF SPACE:** You are allowed to SELL ONLY FROM YOUR BOOTH. There is no one walking up and down the aisles selling goods or distributing literature. Amplifying devices are limited to official use only.

- **Booth assignments and location are at the sole discretion of the IslandFest Chairperson.**
