

GROSSE ILE ISLANDFEST FESTIVAL

Rules and Food Concession Application

APPLICATIONS: All applicants must qualify under applicable state, county and city laws and regulations and obtain all required permits, licenses, certifications and liability insurance in the amount of \$1 million with Grosse Ile Township and Grosse Ile Municipal Airport as additionally named insured.

ALL APPLICATION MUST include the following information to be considered complete:

- All applications must be postmarked by March 23, 2012.
- Applications must include a detailed drawing of your space requirements which will include all overhangs, trailer tongues, ice machines, refrigerators, storage containers, tables, and cooking area (*ALL* cooking *MUST* be done within the confines of your booth).
- Include all electrical requirements. No gas generators will be allowed unless approved by the Grosse Ile Township Fire Department.
- Make check payable to **Grosse Ile Township** and be sure to include your completed and signed application.
- All food vendors must have concessions trailers. Copy of your menu – subject to Commission approval.

ALL INFORMATION MUST BE CURRENT. “SAME AS LAST YEAR” WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- **ACCEPTANCE:** The applicant acknowledges decisions with request to applications, will be necessarily subjective and applicant specifically waives, releases, and hold harmless, the Festival Commission, Grosse Ile Municipal Airport, and Grosse Ile Township, from any claims, actions, or damages arising out of an application denial.
- **ASSUPTION OF RISK:** ALL VENDORS participating in the Festival do so at their own risk. This assumption of risk includes that associated with wind, rain, hail, lightning, floods, or other acts of God. Therefore damage to property, illness or injury, by vandals, patrons, fellow participants, or sponsors are at the vendors own risk. The Festival Commission, Grosse Ile Township, Grosse Ile Municipal Airport, and its elected officials, employees, agents, and volunteers shall not be liable for any damages to or losses of property, injury to persons.
- **BOOTH MAINTENANCE:** You must keep the area clean around your booth. There will be a minimum charge of \$100 if the Festival Commission has to clean your space. An additional \$100 will be charged anyone dumping grease or waste directly into the sewers. It is your responsibility to secure all trip hazards (i.e. electrical cords, hoses, ropes, etc.).
- **DELIVERIES/VEHICLE TRAFFIC:** All concessions must be set up by 4:00 p.m. on June 1. Vehicles will not be allowed on festival grounds for delivery or storage during festival hours, which are 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Friday, 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday and 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. Arrangements should be made in advance for the storage of vehicles and trailers. *ALL* deliveries coming after the opening of the festival each day will have to be brought in by hand. Vehicles parked in unauthorized area will be ticketed or towed at the expense of the owner. Parking permits must be visible in the windshield of your vehicle.
- **FEES:** Rental space is \$375.00.
- **GENERAL RULES:** Please be aware that general rules do not allow pets, bottles, cans, bicycles, roller blades, scooters or skateboards in the festival area.
- **LIABILITY:** NO INSURANCE PROVIDED by the Festival Commission. Grosse Ile Township and the Festival Commission shall not be liable for loss or damages to equipment or for any injuries to vendors.
- **SANITATION:** Port-a-toilets will be provided throughout the Festival area.
- **SECURITY:** Security will be provided for observation only after festival closing hours.
- **USE OF SPACE:** You are allowed to *SELL ONLY FROM YOUR BOOTH*. There is no one walking up and down the street selling goods or distributing literature. Amplifying devices are limited to official use only. *NO* charcoal fires. Drip pans *MUST* be under grills. *NO* gas generators allowed unless approved by the Grosse Ile Fire Department. All cooking must be done within the enclosed confines of your booth.
