

WATER'S EDGE MUNICIPAL MARINA
Rules & Guidelines for Winter Storage 2008-2009

- Water's Edge Marina provides storage for approximately 80 boats. Storage is arranged on a first come, first serve basis.
- **Arrangements for haul out and blocking are made directly through Bob Lang, lift operator at (734)407-2400. Call during business hours, Monday through Friday. Schedule haul-out by October 15.**
- Payment in full is required at the time of service to Bob Lang. The fee includes haul out, bottom power wash, blocking or cradling, and spring launch.
 - Year-round customers: \$1.55 per sq. ft. / with stands
 - Year-round customers: \$1.70 per sq. ft. / without stands
 - Winter only customers: \$1.80 per sq. ft. / with stands
 - Winter only customers: \$1.95 per sq. ft. / without stands
- If circumstances occur that the boat is pulled from the water and racked, but payment is not received; the boat will be marked "Do Not Move" indicating that the boat owner/marina storage patron is delinquent in payment. The boat will not be moved back into the water or to ground transportation until payment is received in full.
- The boat owner/marina storage patron must be present and have jack stands if available, when his/her boat is hauled out for storage.
- Occupancy during the winter season is prohibited.
- Current proof of insurance must be supplied to the Grosse Ile Recreation-Water's Edge Marina office prior to haul out and storage date.
- During Winter Storage, boats cannot be plugged into shore power unless the boat owner is on the premises doing general maintenance. Use of shore power is not permitted when the boat is unattended. Non-compliance with this rule will necessitate strict enforcement of a Fire Department ordinance that requires electrical power in the marina be disconnected from November 15 through March 15.
- Eliminate the possibility of theft by removing all electronic equipment, tools, and loose marine items from your craft. Lock your boat and check on it often.
- Report damage/problems regarding marina property or systems to the Water's Edge office so that repairs can be made.
- The boat owner/ marina storage patron will keep his/her area clean and free of debris. Failure to do so will result in additional charges and postponement or cancellation of services.
- All boats must be launched or otherwise off marina property by the first weekend in June. Any boat not launched by the first weekend in June is subject to a daily late launch fee.
