

Bicycle and Pedestrian Commission Development

The Township needs your help to fill positions on the newly formed Bicycle and Pedestrian Commission.

The aim is to have a board familiar with the variety of perspectives on bicycle and pedestrian travel—casual cyclists, expert cyclists, walkers/joggers/hikers, dog-walkers, rollerbladers, parents with strollers, persons with disabilities, school representatives, businesses, homeowners, apartment dwellers, etc.

The first order of business will be to develop commission by-laws. Afterwards, the commission will hold televised meetings, in accordance with open-meetings act and serve as a one-stop shop for everything bike/ped. Duties include:

- Advising the Township on bicyclist and pedestrian issues;
- Analyzing routing, operation and safety of bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure;
- Reviewing and making recommendations regarding the Township's Capital Improvement Plan and Bicycle Master Plan based on bicycle and pedestrian issues;
- Evaluating and making recommendations for an action plan for biking and walking facilities (on-street and off-street paths and lanes, bicycle racks, signage, and signalization);
- Coordinating with external agencies on maps and regional connections;
- Developing education and public outreach programs on bicycle and pedestrian issues; and
- Assisting the Township in the development of bicycle and pedestrian systems within the community.
