GINLC Liz Hugel	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The conservancy is interested in participating in grant applications for improvements to nature areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Centennial Farm open space – interpretive trail ▪ Centennial Farm or Airport Recreation Area general fitness trail ▪ Airport Recreation Area – trails need improvements [and] educational signage 2) Nature Trails: Improve the many nature trails in the open space to encourage people to get outside, walk, and enjoy nature. 3) Airport Recreation Area: The northwestern part has trails but they are not always passable due to the area being a wetland, i.e. drainage creek/swales cross the path. 4) Centennial Farm Open Space: The current Master Plan specifically notes the Centennial Farm property as having a trail to develop further, however the Open Space Committee is reluctant to approve improvements. Pedestrian access at the west end (Meridian Road) is difficult and needs delineation to stay clear of private property. There is no signage at any of the entrances or instructions for use; motorized vehicles use the property inappropriately; public education needed. Area needs trash/recycling cans to control litter. 5) 80-acre Woods: The wooded space just east of Meridian School has a trail but no signage for the entrance or instructions for use. Some interpretative signs for the variety of trees or other landmarks would be beneficial. 6) Water Access: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Residents need an access point for launching small boats, kayaks, etc., with a waterfront picnic area. Boat launch at Water's Edge is an option, but access on East River would be more desirable, e.g. township

Where can people, e.g. kids go with their bikes and fishing poles? <p>7) Walkways and/or Bike Paths: Increase the number of safe places to walk, job and for children to bike. Township roads should have signs for separating “commuter/racing/exercise” bicycles from vehicles.</p> <p>8) East River Road: Develop a path on E. River south of Groh Rd. This is a natural extension of the Meridian-Groh Rd. Greenway. It is necessary for safer access to the Gibraltar Bay Nature Area and the high-density residential areas on Hickory Island. Negotiate with federal agencies to separate pathway from road.</p> <p>9) E. River Rd. between Manchester and Horsemill is an extremely busy walkway. Develop walkways and/or bicycle lanes. Demarcation is necessary to separate vehicles and pedestrians, especially children walking or biking to school.</p> <p>10) East-West Paths: Grays Drive for safer travel by HS and MS children. Manchester to Bellevue, although it’s necessary to avoid removal of current trees.</p>
