

## REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS

The **Township of Grosse Ile (Owner)**, Michigan (“MI”), is requesting quotations for the removal of the epoxy floor at Grosse Ile Fire and Rescue Apparatus areas and applying concrete sealant and concrete protector thereafter. The scope of the work comprises the following items:

In addition to the above items, Contractor shall be responsible for the below listed numerical items:

1. Contractor is responsible for transportation and disposal of materials outside the Township Limit.

All quotations shall include, as a minimum, the following provisions and information:

1. All of the significant assumptions on which the pricing is based;
2. A total project cost to the **Township of Grosse Ile** for the removal and replacement of all

described items.

3. Professional Liability of \$1,000,000. Proof of coverage must be provided with Proposal;
4. Description of the specific experience in the State of Michigan with similar type projects;
5. Maintenance and Guarantee Bond Required;
6. Time of the Essence:
  - A. Work shall begin **on or before June 17, 2019** weather permitted.
  - B. Work shall be final completed **on or before June 25, 2019.**

The selection of a Firm to undertake this project will be based on professional qualifications, experience and expertise of the personnel, and ability to meet deadlines. The proposal shall include the necessary information on personnel assigned to the work and a chart of the project schedule including the promised start and finish deadline dates.

Proposers shall make necessary visits to the site. The proposer's failure to familiarize themselves with the site along with Township, State and Federal laws, bridge weight restrictions, or other unseen or latent conditions shall not be cause for the proposer to seek additional funds for this project.

#### **EVALUATION OF SUBMITTALS**

The **Public Safety Commission** will evaluate the quotations and the respondents presenting them. The **Board** will make its decision based on information gathered during the procurement process and based upon the recommendation of the **Public Safety Commission**.

The **Board** regards the submission of the quotation as the most important factor in the selection of a respondent to provide the services described herein. The Township reserves the right to reject any and all of the proposals, to waive any informalities and to award a contract to the proposer whom the Board deems serves the best interest of the **Township of Grosse Ile**.

The **Board** shall not be responsible for any costs incurred by responding to this Request for Quotations ("RFQ"). Further, the **Township of Grosse Ile** shall not be responsible for any costs incurred by participating in an oral presentation or costs associated with negotiations.

**A properly completed Bid Bond, Certified Check or Cashier's Check in a sum not less than five (5) percent of the proposed amount of the proposal submitted, shall accompany each proposal as security for acceptance of the Contract by the lowest qualified bidder.**
