Over the past several weeks, Township Board and Administration have been monitoring the situation regarding the Coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic. Over the past few days the Federal, State, and County advisories have stressed the importance of minimizing and limiting contact and interaction. Due to the recent Michigan DHHS Director Gordon's Emergency Order effective Wednesday, November 18, 2020 Township Hall, Township Recreation, and the Department of Public Services are closed to the public. This closure is expected to last for a duration of approximately three weeks.

Township staff will continue to provide service by use of the Township website, Township Hall drop box, and via telephone and email. Residents are encouraged to pay bills online or by use of the Township Hall drop box. The main telephone number is 734-676-4422, ext. 234.

Trash and recycling service shall remain unchanged. After hour watermain breaks or water service issues can be reported by calling 734-676-7100. All other DPS matters should be directed to 734-676-4422, ext. 228.
